The tradition of hospital care at Del Norte goes back to 1907. Rio Grande Hospital at Del Norte opened in January 1996 in the old St. Joseph Hospital building. The new Rio Grande Hospital facility opened in August 2004.

Services include: Emergency care, outpatient, inpatient and swingbed care, laboratory and x-ray, CT, MRI, ultrasound, respiratory therapy and physical therapy.

We have an outpatient surgery area performing cataract removal, colonoscopies, EGD's, and orthopedic.



Nurses Station

Cardiac and respiratory monitoring equipment transmits information from rooms to this central station.



Emergency Room

Evaluation and care for emergencies and acute illness are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Rio Grande Hospital is approved by the State of Colorado as a trauma center – Level IV.



Patient Room

The patient rooms are spacious, comfortable and private. Each room is provided with a full bathroom and a new television with cable programming.



Radiology

A 64-slice CT scanner is available in our x-ray department. We use digital x-ray equipment to reduce patient radiation exposure.

Ultrasound testing is available for outpatient and inpatient needs.



Laboratory

The laboratory has state-of-the-art equipment and serves the hospital and surrounding clinics and nursing homes.
